Parking Regulations

Students must abide by the parking rules and regulations for the entire school year. Violation of any of these rules may result in the vehicle being towed, the loss of parking privileges on the Peachtree Ridge campus, or a fine depending on the violation and whether or not it is a repeat offense. After reading the parking rules and regulations, all students applying for a parking permit are required to sign the *Parking Rules Acceptance Sheet* (see page 2).

Parking Rules and Regulations

PRHS parking decals must be hung from the rear view mirror from the first day of parking. All old parking decals must be removed. **Students may not give, sell, or transfer their parking decals to another student.** If this is done, parking privileges will be immediately revoked to both students. Mrs. Driscoll's office handles all decal assignments and transfers.

Students cannot park in faculty-designated areas **at any time including after school hours.**

Students are not allowed to **back in or pull** through a space.

Students must notify Mrs. Driscoll's office to drive a vehicle to school other than the vehicle that has been registered.

Horn blowing, tire squealing, fast starts, loud mufflers, and excessive noise are not allowed in the parking lot at any time before and after school hours.

Students must obey the 10 mile per hour speed limit at all times on school property. Pedestrians and school buses always have the right-of-way.

There is to be no loitering in the parking lot. Students must leave their vehicle and the parking lot immediately upon arriving at school and then enter the school building. Students may not re-enter the parking lot during the day without written permission from an administrator or a checkout pass from the attendance office. Vehicles may not be used as a locker.

Illegal substances such as alcohol, tobacco products, lighters, matches, drugs, drug paraphernalia, weapons, gang symbols/literature may not be in any vehicle on school property. This includes glove compartments, consoles, trunks and all other areas of the vehicle. **The school administration has the right to search all areas of your vehicle when on school property.**

Cutting across parking spaces or driving the wrong way in the lanes is not permissible when entering or exiting the parking lot. All driving must be in the driving lanes between spaces.

Students parking improperly, in the faculty parking lot, in the bus lanes, in visitor designated spaces, in restricted or reserved zones, or in non-registered vehicles will be fined, have their parking permit revoked, and possibly have their vehicle towed at the student's expense without prior notification.

Parking privileges will be revoked at the end of the first term if the student fails more than one class or has more than 7 absences in anyone class. Parking privileges will be revoked for one week if the student acquires five unexcused tardies and for two weeks if the student acquires six tardies. At seven tardies, the permit will be revoked for the remainder of the term.

Disciplinary action for violation of any school rule including AWOL may result in loss of parking privileges.

Parking citations will be issued for infractions of rules. Fines should be paid to the Parking Lot Attendant within five school days of the ticket. Failure to pay by the end of five school days will result in the fine being increased for each additional five school days it is not paid.

All students that park on the Peachtree Ridge High School campus are required to have liability and personal injury insurance on the registered vehicle throughout the entire school year. In cases of accidents occurring on campus, it is up to the individuals involved to settle damages. The school is not responsible for any damages, loss or theft to any vehicle or its contents while on campus.

Students should take the necessary precautions to prevent loss to their vehicle and its contents by keeping the vehicle locked at all times, not giving the keys to anyone else, not leaving valuable items inside the vehicle while on campus, and obeying all the above regulations. Peachtree Ridge High School will not be held responsible for damage to automobiles.
